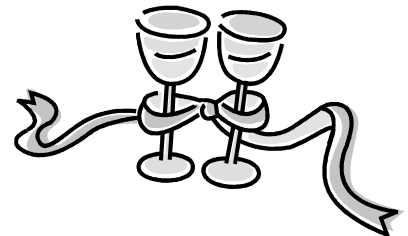
The Future
